Day 1 - Chicago

Arrive at Chicago. Transfer to the hotel on a private basis and check-in at the hotel. Later in the evening, free time for leisure. Overnight in Chicago.

Day 2 - Chicago

Today, after breakfast proceed to the Field Museum in Chicago which showcases natural history, with extensive exhibits on fossils, ancient cultures, and biodiversity. Today, all transfers will be on private basis. The vehicle will be at your disposal. After that enjoy the Shedd Aquarium which is an impressive variety of aquatic life. From the anaconda, piranhas, arapaima, and stingrays of the Amazon to the exotic coral of a Philippine reef. Afternoon, proceed to explore the Art Institute of Chicago houses an extensive collection of artworks, including iconic pieces by Monet, Van Gogh, and Picasso. Later in the evening, proceed to explore Skydeck Chicago, atop Willis Tower, offers panoramic views of the city and features glass floor ledges for thrilling experiences. After that enjoy visit Millennium Park in Chicago features iconic attractions like the Cloud Gate sculpture ("The Bean"), Crown Fountain, gardens, and outdoor performance venues. Overnight in Atlanta.

Day 8 - Atlanta

Today, after breakfast proceed to the Atlanta Botanical Garden - Walk through the treetops on the Kendeda Canopy Walk, exploring the Venus flytraps in the Soggy Bog, and learning about honeybees in the observation hive, the Fuqua Orchid Center- see a rare collection of high-elevation orchids and many more. Today, all transfers will be on private basis. The vehicle will be at your disposal. Afternoon, proceed to the Martin Luther King, Jr. National Historical Park in Atlanta which includes his birth home, church, and gravesite, celebrating his legacy. Later in the evening, free time at leisure. Transfer back to the hotel. Overnight in Atlanta.

Day 9 - Atlanta

Today, after breakfast check-out from the hotel. Transfer to Atlanta International Airport on private basis. Fly back to hometown with beautiful memories.
