Day 09: Las Vegas • Death Valley

Breakfast on your own and check out from the Hotel. Today we will proceed to Death Valley National park (only visit in the Winter season) which takes approx. 2.5 hours drive from Las Vegas is a desert valley



located in Eastern California. It is the driest place with a view of the desert, vast valley, sculpted peaks, adapted plants. Visit the old ghost town of Rhyolite, a long-abandoned gold mining community, and Badwater - the lowest point in California. Overnight at Death Valley.

Day 10: Death Valley • Mammoth Lakes

Breakfast at the Hotel and check out. Take a drive towards the next destination that is Mammoth Lakes. It takes around 3 hours to reach Mammoth lakes. Reach and check in to the Hotel. Mammoth lakes the name speaks to the size of the mountains, the expanse of the valleys, the incredible number of crystal clear mountain lakes, and the endless opportunities for adventure. It is a large freshwater lake in the Sierra Nevada known as the world's largest alpine lake and America's second deepest. In the evening, experience the Dinner Cruise starts at 6 that offers an unforgettable Tahoe sunset. Enjoy fresh menus as you cruise against a backdrop of astonishing views over Emerald Bay. Signature cocktails and fine wines are available for purchase on-board. Enjoy dinner and with the astonishing view of the lake. Overnight at Lake Tahoe.

Day 13 Lake Tahoe • San Francisco
