Helsinki (1N) - O/N Cruise (1N) - Stockholm (1N) - Copenhagen (1N) - Odense (1N) - O/N Cruise (1N) - Bergen (1N) - Geiranger (2N) - Flam Area (1N) - Oslo (2N)

Day 01: Arrive in Helsinki (Finland)

Arrive at Helsinki Airport – the capital city of Finland. After immigration and baggage collection, board your coach, transfer to the hotel and check-in (standard check-in time is 1500 hrs.). The day is kept free for leisure. Overnight in Helsinki.

Day 02: Helsinki • Stockholm (Sweden)

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Proceed to enjoy a guided city tour of Helsinki, where we can visit the City Hall, Parliament House, Presidential Palace, Monumental Railroad Station, Lutheran Church, Olympic Stadium, Sibelius Monument, Rock Church & Market Place. Later we will be dropped at the cruise port. Depart for Stockholm – capital city of Sweden. Overnight in the Cruise.

Day 03: Stockholm

Breakfast on board and disembark from the Cruise. On arrival directly proceed to enjoy a guided city tour. Enjoy walking in the Old Town where we can visit the Royal Palace, the Cathedral, the Main Square and the Noble Price Museum (all from outside). Later visit the Magnificent Town Hall and Vasa Ship Museum from the inside. Transfer to the cruise port and depart for Helsinki Turku – a city in Southwest Finland, located along the Aura River. Later enjoy one of the following options of sightseeing: ABBA the Museum: a highly interactive journey through one of the greatest pop careers in musical history. Globe Arena from where one can enjoy an unobstructed view of the city. There is some time kept free for leisure and then visit the most awaited experience – the Ice-Bar, which is a bar made of ice where we can enjoy our drinks in an ice glass! Overnight in Stockholm.

Day 04: Stockholm • Copenhagen (Denmark)

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Today proceed to Copenhagen by direct train. On arrival we will be transferred to the hotel, check-in and relax for some time before proceeding to the Tivoli Garden – second oldest operating amusement park in the world, in the evening. Overnight in Copenhagen.

Day 05: Copenhagen • Odense

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Proceed to enjoy a guided city tour of Copenhagen where we will see the Renaissance Stock Exchange, also known as Børsbygningen, a 17th-century stock exchange in the centre of Copenhagen. Rosenborg Palace from outside where there is a famous statue of the Little



Mermaid – a bronze statue by Edvard Eriksen, depicting a mermaid becoming human followed by the Christiansborg Palace – a palace and a government building. It is the seat of the Danish Parliament, the Danish Prime Minister's Office, and the Supreme Court of Denmark. Later proceed to Odense – the third largest city of Denmark and the birthplace of Hans Christian Andersen. Overnight in Odense.

Day 06: Odense • Overnight Cruise

Breakfast at the hotel and-check out. Explore Odense where we can visit the Andersen House and Odense Zoo. Later proceed to Hirtshals. Enroute explore the Aarhus City of Denmark. Depart for Bergen. Overnight in the Cruise.

Day 07: Bergen (Norway)

Breakfast on board and disembark from the Cruise. Directly proceed to enjoy a guided tour of Bergen and admire its old streets, historic buildings and harbor followed by Mt. Floyen Funicular Tram and enjoy a panoramic view of Bergen from the top. Check-in at the hotel and relax. Overnight in Bergen.

Day 08: Bergen • Geiranger

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Today proceed to Geiranger – a small village located in the Geiranger fjord. Enroute enjoy the scenic beauty of the area. Arrive, check in at hotel and relax. Overnight in Geiranger.

Day 09: Geiranger

Breakfast at the hotel. Today proceed to enjoy the Geiranger Fjord Cruise, Geiranger fjord which is surrounded by majestic, snow-covered mountain peaks, wild waterfalls and lush, green vegetation. The rest of the day is kept free for you to explore the small village on own.

Day 10: Geiranger • Flam Area

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Today proceed to enjoy the Dalsnibba viewpoint from where one can enjoy the view of the Geiranger fjord area, and it is Europe's highest fjord view by road. Later proceed directly to Flam Area and enjoy the beautiful scenery enroute. Arrive and check-in at hotel. Overnight in Flam Area.

Day 11: Flam Area • Oslo

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Today proceed to enjoy the Flam Railway till Myrdal – one of the most beautiful train journeys in the world. From Myrdal take a Bergen express till Geilo and from there board a bus till Oslo. Overnight in Oslo.

Day 12: Oslo

Breakfast at the hotel. In the morning proceed to enjoy a guided city tour of Oslo. We can visit the



Holmenkollen Ski Jump (photo-stop), City Hall, Parliament House, National Theatre, Old Cathedral and Viking Museum: Museum on the Bygdøy peninsula with the world's best-preserved Viking ships and finds from Viking tombs around the Oslo Fjord. Followed by the Vigeland Sculpture park – a sculpture park in the Frogner Park with more than 200 sculptures by Gustav Vigeland in bronze, granite and cast iron. In the evening spend time at Karl Johan's Gate, where one can enjoy shopping. Overnight in Oslo.

Day 13: Oslo • Homeward Bound

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Depart for the airport and board your flight back home.
