Day 01 – Toronto to Niagara Falls – 125 Kms

Arrive at Toronto International Airport and pick up the vehicle from the car rental agency located within the airport premises. Journey Behind the Falls -Descend through bedrock and explore 130-year-old tunnels, feeling the thunderous vibration of the Horseshoe Falls, come face-to-face with this 13-story tall wonder as 1/5 of the world's freshwater crashes down in front of you. Niagara's Fury – Discover the ancient story of the formation of Niagara Falls through this multi-sensory experience. Step inside our 360-degree theatre where stunning sound and visuals will transport you back in time to the last ice age.White Water Walk – This tranquil boardwalk offers incredible views of the Niagara River's Class 6 whitewater rapids and an opportunity to learn more about the unique geological history of the Niagara Gorge, get an up-close and personal. You can try your luck at one of the casinos in Niagara before you go back to bed in Niagara Hotel.

Day 03 – Niagara Falls to Toronto 130 Kms

Visit CN Tower – Canada's most recognizable and celebrated icon. An express glass elevator will take you to its observation desk in few seconds. You can walk on glass-bottom floors 553 meters above ground level. If you can looking for an ultimate lifetime experience, opt for The Edge walk- It is the world's highest full circle hands-free walk on a 5 ft (1.5 m) wide ledge encircling the top of the Tower's main pod, 356m/1168ft (116 storeys) above the ground. EdgeWalk is a Canadian Signature Experience. Overnight in a Toronto hotel.

Day 04 – Toronto to Ottawa 450 Kms

After breakfast, check out of the hotel, drive east all along the coast of Lake Ontario. Day 05 – Ottawa to Montreal 200 Kms

Drive along and see Parliament buildings, Embassies of different countries, Universities and colleges, scenic gardens, the National Gallery of Canada, the Museum of Civilisation, the residence of the Prime Minister. You can take a boat ride on Rideau Canal, one of Ottawa's picturesque waterways. You can also opt to take a tour of the Royal Canadian Mint. After lunch, proceed to Montreal, Canada's most vibrant, multicultural, cosmopolitan French city. After check-in hotel, you have choices to stroll through the Botanical Garden or spend time at the spa or the Casino de Montreal. Downtown Montreal offers excellent choices of restaurants and food. Overnight in Montreal Hotel.

Day 06 – Montreal

After breakfast, the day is at leisure. Explore Montreal at your own speed. There are art & Culture centers, the campus of McGill University, and a panoramic view from an observation point on top of Mont-Royal. Visit Notre-Dame Basilica - a Basilica renowned for its finest Gothic Revival architecture with extraordinarily rich interior decoration. Visit Olympic Complex, St. Joseph Oratory. You also have an option to do activities Explore optional activities like Biodome, St. Lawrence River Jet Boating, and much more. Overnight in Montreal hotel.

Day 07- Montreal- Quebec City 250 Kms

Montreal to Quebec city is just not a drive but it's the most scenic drive in Eastern Canada. You can take highway 40 to have a more relaxed ramble through historic towns, lush wineries, and quaint shopping districts. Quebec's countryside is full of scenic experiences, you can wander woods, enjoy farm-to-table fare, see old sites of New France, and savor the uniquely Quebecois culture. Upon arrival in Quebec City, check-in at the hotel and later stroll through the UNESCO World Heritage Site of the old city which offers a touch of Europe and is quite distinct from the rest of Canada. This is the city is dominated by the historic Fairmont Le Château Frontenac, it's the only existing walled city north of Mexico, and the city's extraordinary people and attractions—as well as its architecture—will tempt you to linger more. Overnight in Quebec City Hotel.

Day 08- Quebec City - Montreal- 250 Kms

After breakfast check out and keep luggage in the lobby. Visit Montmorency Falls, via route 440 just a few kilometers northeast of downtown Quebec City, at 272 feet it's actually higher than Niagara Falls, though

its water volume is far lower. Back to Quebec city, explore the Latin Quarter, the Plains of Abraham, the Citadel, the National Assembly, Place Royale, the Basilica. You will definitely feel like you are in Paris. Evening drive back to Montreal for an overnight stay in a hotel.

Day 09- Montreal - Flyback -Onward journey

After breakfast, return your vehicle to the designated point as advised by the car hiring company. Flyback or proceed on your onward journey to explore Canada.
